

Observations

None of the patients have exhibited symptoms of gonorrhea.

May 12, 1947, [redacted] [TN: inserted by hand: [redacted]] exhibited one drop of pus. On the 14<sup>th</sup>, he had a lot of pus. Cult. Pos. 5-14

Typical gonorrhea. On May 16, 1947, he was treated with penicillin, 20,000 every 2 hours, for 75 injections.

Note: This patient was treated in the Dermatology Service for Generalized Furunculosis.

May 14, 1947. As soon as [redacted] woke up, I saw a lot of secretion of thick yellow pus. Also [redacted] = Pos. 5-16 ([redacted])

May 17, 1947, upon awakening, both presented a drop of white pus.

*Cult. + isolated = penicillin 20,000 uq 4x5, 1st trial*
