## #1 SYPHILIS

Clinical History of [REDACTED]


The chancre on the labia majora was cleaned with saline solution and pressure and the saline solution was extracted. The saline solution was then placed in a spirochete culture solution. The dark field obtained from the chancre was positive however the dark field examination of the cultured solution was negative.

We injected  $\frac{1}{2}$  cm<sup>3</sup> of this fluid into the inner labia of the cervix using a #20 needle.

*These patients were prepared to send to the penitentiary as part of the study to determine normal rate of infection. Both developed positive STS for syphilis & were eventually treated, but neither showed any clinical evidence upon repeat physical examination.*
